Easter Island

DAY 1 SANTIAGO – EASTER ISLAND

Transfer to the airport for flight to Easter Island (6 hrs). Welcome at Easter Island airport, reception with flower arrangement and transfer to hotel. Free afternoon to visit the village of Hanga Roa, its church, market and fishermen's cove.

DAY 2 ORONGO & RANO KAU – REGULAR

In the morning, guided tour of some of the most important ceremonial centers of Easter Island. The tour includes cave paintings and archaeological sites of great cultural value, an ascent to the Rano Kau volcano and an interpretive trail through the ancestral village of Orongo. This route allows visitors to immerse in Rapa Nui mythology, learn about important elements of the island's geography and understand the enigmatic history of the ancient inhabitants of this isolated spot on the planet. This visit incorporates the places where the Tangata Manu (Birdman) competition takes place every year, based on a fundamental legend of the Rapa Nui culture. The myth states that the man who captures the first egg of the Manutara (characteristic Easter Island bird) will be invested with supernatural powers and will exercise the political-military leadership of the island for a year.

AHU AKIVI & PUNA PAU

In the afternoon, we will know and understand the connection of the ancient inhabitants of Easter Island with the Universe. The excursion includes ceremonial centers erected in the central area of the island during the last period of Moai construction, the most important of the Rapa Nui culture. Megalithic archaeological sites stand out, showing how astronomy determined the arrangement of the giant statues and the platforms on which they stand, making it possible to enter into the cosmovision of the ancient Polynesian navigators who populated Easter Island. All the points visited incorporate ancient sites that were created and used during the end of the Ahu-Moai phase. These sites represent varied cultural developments of Rapa Nui history, all strategically deployed around ceremonial centers. It includes three restored sites: Ahu Huri a Urenga, Ahu a Kivi, Ahu Vai Tekia and the Puna Pau quarry, where the most attractive Pukao (red slag hats or headdresses that crown the heads of some Moai) are found.

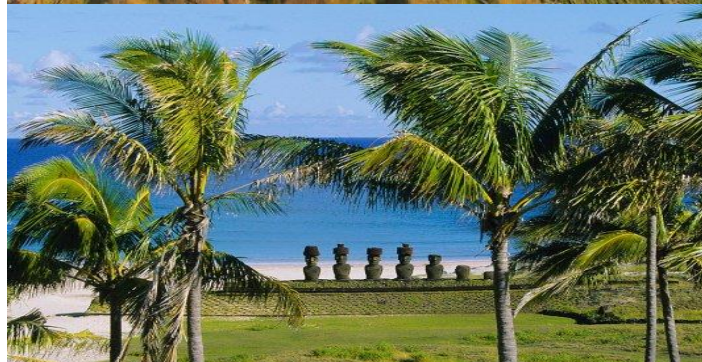


DAY 3 RANO RARAKU Y AHU AKIVI EXCURSION - REGULAR

Full day excursion to the east coast, where the temples of Akahanga and Ahu Tongariki, the largest platform with 15 statues rebuilt in 1992, are located. Visit the extinct volcano Rano Raraku and its quarry where the moais were made, on whose slopes there are more than 390 statues. Picnic lunch. The tour continues with a visit to Ahu Te Pito Kura, to end our mystical tour at Anakena beach.

DAY 4 EASTER ISLAND - SANTIAGO

Free morning. Transfer to the airport to return to Santiago. Overnight at the airport hotel.
