

Atacama. Lakes and Patagonia

DAY 1 WELCOME TO CHILE AND CITY TOUR (D)

Welcome at the Santiago airport and transfer to the selected hotel. In the afternoon, city tour in Santiago, beginning with the historic downtown district, visiting Main Square, Cathedral, Post Office Headquarters, and Santiago City Hall. We will also see the Government House "La Moneda". Then, we will take you to East Santiago, where you may appreciate modern buildings, with offices, apartments, shopping centers, and restaurants. Return to hotel and overnight.



DAY 2 WINE TOUR AND VISIT TO VALPARAISO (D)

Breakfast in the hotel. Full-day tour to the coastal cities of Viña del Mar and Valparaíso, visiting the Quinta Vergara Amphitheater, where the International Song Festival of Viña del Mar is held every year, San Martín and Peru Avenues, Sotomayor Square, the picturesque El Peral Funicular and Yugoslav Corridor in the colorful hills of Valparaíso. Return to Santiago and overnight.



DAY 3 SANTIAGO – ATACAMA – MOON VALLEY (D)

Transfer to Santiago airport for flight to Calama in the Atacama Desert. Reception at El Loa airport in Calama. Transfer to San Pedro de Atacama, via Domeyko Mountain Range. In the afternoon, excursion to Moon Valley, passing through the Salt Mountain Range, with a panoramic view of "Las Tres Marias". This excursion concludes enjoying a magical sunset, with a privileged view of the valley. Return to San Pedro.



DAY 4 SALAR DE ATACAMA, LAGUNAS ALTIPLÁNICAS (D-A)

Breakfast in the hotel. Excursion to Atacama Salt Flat, Chaxa Lagoon, and Flamingos National Reserve, to observe three out of the six different kinds of flamingos existing in the world. Transfer to the high plain lagoons of Miscanti and Miñiques. Lunch in Socaire. In the afternoon, visit to the town of Toconao, San Lucas Church, and Campanario Tower. Return to San Pedro.



DAY 5 GEYSERS DEL TATIO (D)

Early in the morning, excursion to El Tatio Geysers, the world's highest geyser field, which erupts each day at dawn, creating unusual mineral formations and spouting high clouds of steam. Trekking to observe various geothermal activities. Breakfast picnic. Return to San Pedro. In the afternoon, visit to Cejar Lagoon, located in the heart of the Atacama Salt Flat, with such a high concentration of salt and lithium that it makes floating easier than on the Dead Sea. You may bathe, swim, and float amidst a beautiful landscape. Return to the hotel.



Day 6 CALAMA- SANTIAGO – PUERTO MONTT

Transfer to Calama airport for flight to Puerto Montt. Reception and transfer to the city. Overnight

DAY 7 PEULLA NAVIGATION

Excursion to Ensenada, bordering Lake Llanquihue. Visit to the Petrohue River Falls and navigation through the Todos los Santos Lake to Peulla, along with the panoramic view of the Osorno, Puntiagudo and Tronador volcanoes. Return to Puerto Varas.



DAY 8 CHILOE ISLAND (D-A)

Magical full day journey, departing from Puerto Varas. To immerse ourselves in the Chilote world, we will start the day sailing for 30 minutes through the Chacao Canal, where we will be able to observe a great variety of birds, until we reach the town of Chacao, where we will visit the town square and church. We will continue our trip to Castro, with time for lunch. Then we will visit the stilt houses of Río Gamboa, the square and its church, declared a World Heritage Site by Unesco.



DAY 9 PUERTO MONTT – PUNTA ARENAS

Transfer to the airport to flight to Punta Arenas. Welcome and transfer to hotel.



DAY 10 NAVIGATION MAGDALENA ISLAND

In the morning, we sail through the Magellan Strait towards Magdalena Island. Disembark on the island to interact with the largest colony of Magellan Penguins. Return to Punta Arenas. Afternoon transfer by bus service to Puerto Natales (250 km). Overnight. (only October to March)

DAY 11 TORRES DEL PAINE AND MILODÓN CAVE

Excursion to Torres del Paine, visiting the Cave of the Milodon, where they discovered well-preserved remains of this prehistoric herbivore that existed 12,000 years ago. From here, journey will continue into Torres del Paine National Park, where we will visit Nordenskjold Lake, Pehoe Lake, and Salto Grande. Lunch. Short hike through a forest of lenga trees towards a viewpoint of Grey Glacier, with its impressive ice floes. Afterward, visit to Amarga Lagoon and return to Puerto Natales.

DAY 12 GLACIERS NAVIGATION

Transfer to pier to begin boat tour through Last Hope Fjord en route to Balmaceda and Serrano Glaciers. During the traverse, we will observe seal and cormorant colonies. Upon arrival at Serrano Glacier, we will dock at Toro Port and walk over half a mile through native forests. Patagonia-style lunch and cruise back to Puerto Natales.

DAY 13 PUNTA ARENAS – SANTIAGO

Transfer to Punta Arenas airport by bus line for flight back to Santiago. Reception at Santiago airport and transfer to hotel.

DAY 14 SANTIAGO

At the arranged time, private transfer to the airport for international flight back home. End of our services.
